The Sun god is called Sol by the Romans as well as by the Germans. It is his task to steer the chariot of the Sun across the sky every day.

The carriage is pulled by 4 stallions.

No other god occurs so often in all cultures and myths. It is the only one of the planets whose light shines during the day, i.e. it is even the reason for the brightness of the day.

The character Helios received a lot of gold. Rays from the Sun fall on the globe. The god acquired a young, optimistic face.

The sculpture is 180cm high.
